

EARLY CAREER OT PROGRAM


A comprehensive, in-house program to support the career development of our early career OTs. This program is perfect for OTs that are recent graduates or those transitioning into Paediatrics from another area of practice.

What it includes:

- Formal training sessions / workshops run by highly experienced OTs (2 hour sessions every 3 weeks).
- Online Learning Modules covering a range of paediatric specific topics
- Formal weekly supervision with a Senior OT.
- Substantial support and informal supervision.
- Networking opportunities with other early career OTs.
- Opportunity to shadow other OTs.
- Gradual build to a full caseload over 6 months.
- Full administrative assistance


Face to Face Training:

Our face to face Early Career OT training is provided by Sumita Quinn (Director, Kids Space OT and OT since 2008) and Laura Ferguson (OT at Infinity Kids).



Our current training schedule topics looks like this:

- Friday 19 May: Emotional Regulation in an OT context
- Friday 9 June: Handwriting Interventions
- Friday 30 June: Alignment, Postural Control and Seating
- Friday 21 July: Trauma Informed Care
- Friday 11 August: Visual Vestibular Integration



Future training topics will be planned in collaboration with our Junior OTs and the topics that are useful and interesting to them.

Online Learning Modules: Available to access at any time.

Topics include:

- Sensory Processing
- Fine and Gross Motor Development
- Working with non-speaking children / children with limited language skills.
- Administering standardised and nonstandardised assessments.
- Writing clinical notes.
